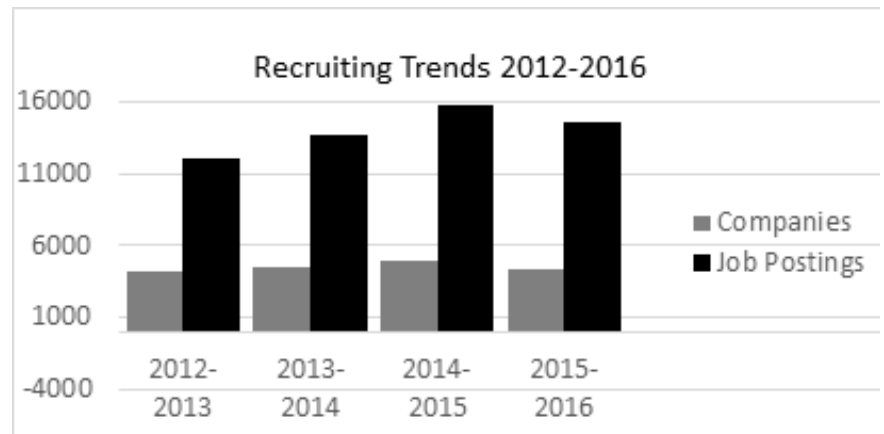

CAREER CENTER

OVERVIEW

- Established in 1939, the Career Center is a comprehensive career planning and employment service for students of all majors and classifications, providing one point of contact to expedite the recruiting efforts of companies and organizations.
- In 2011, more than 7,600 jobs were posted by 2,900 companies and organizations, representing in excess of 34,000 unique positions.
- In 2010-2011, staff had more than 13,500 advising contacts with students and gave over 500 requested workshops and presentations with more than 19,000 attendees.



CAREER COORDINATORS

- Drawing upon a combined 100+ years of previous experience and education related to the specific populations served, the Coordinators are uniquely qualified to advise students about how to achieve their career goals.
- Provide tailored programs, services, and career advising to each college on campus, including college-specific activities such as College Advisory Council meetings, assessment, and regional outreach programs.
- Present to local, regional and national audiences, including the Aggie Moms, A&M Clubs, professional organizations and corporate conferences.

HIGH IMPACT EXPERIENCES

- 34% of May 2011 graduates reported that they participated in internships, cooperative education, or work abroad learning experiences.
- Nearly 400 students participated in one-day AggieExternship experiences at more than 37 employer locations across Texas.
- Continued expansion of the Work Abroad program, including opportunities in Dublin, London, Madrid, Cork, Galway, Seville, Belize, Ecuador, Guatemala, Chile, China and South Africa.

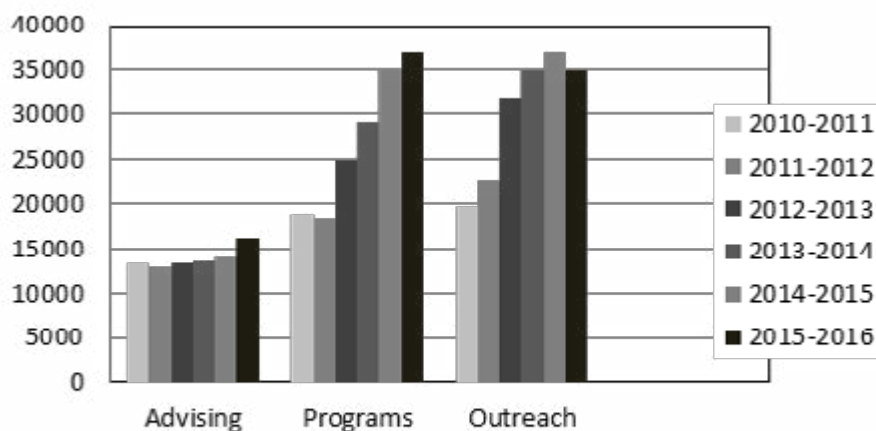
ONLINE RESOURCES AND VIDEOS

- Purchased or produced videos on multiple topics, with more than 8,800 views this past year.
- Video production process selected for presentations nationally and regionally, including national webinars.
- Provide students with access to online resources with national and international employment opportunities and networking contacts.
- Online assessment tools to assist students in making major and career choices.
- Students, both current and former, may participate in mock interviews with option to receive feedback from staff.
- Provide facilities and technology for remote interviews by phone and online.

FORMER STUDENT CAREER SERVICES

- Offered in close partnership with The Association of Former Students.
- Single point of entry to connect former students to online resources and the Aggie Network.
- Provide individual career coaching and access to multiple career networks.
- Staff participated in 26 programs with over 7,500 in attendance and made nearly 1,000 advising contacts.
