- Texas A&M received 35,784 FAFSA applications for their students in the 2015-2016 award year, which comprises approximately 55% of the 65,369 students attending Texas A&M.
- 24% of all undergraduate students are eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant award.
- 61% of enrolled FAFSA filers completed the FAFSA before the March 15 priority deadline.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the first step in the financial aid process for United States citizens and eligible noncitizens. The FAFSA is required in order to receive grants, federal and state loans, and work-study, as well as some private financial aid. For students who are ineligible to file the FAFSA, the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA), and the International Student Financial Aid Application (ISFAA), are available. The federal school code for Texas A&M when filling out the FAFSA is 003632.

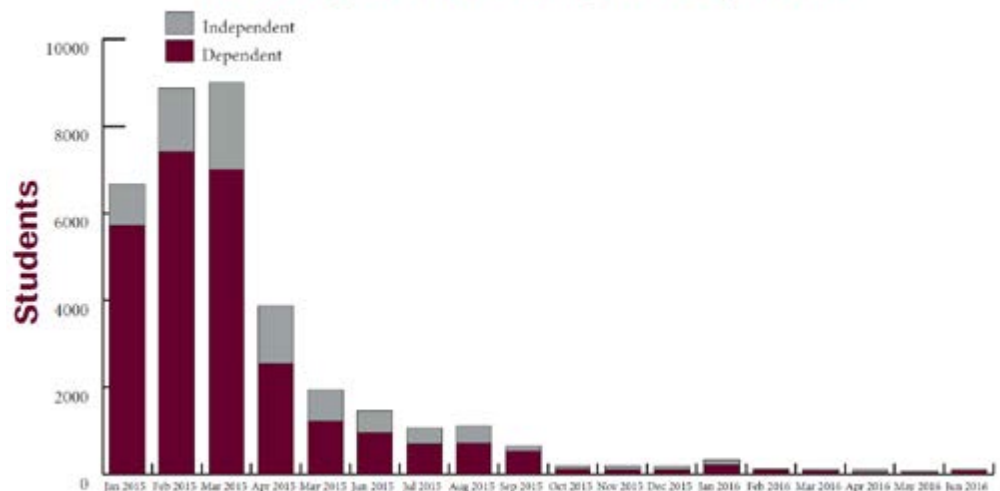
