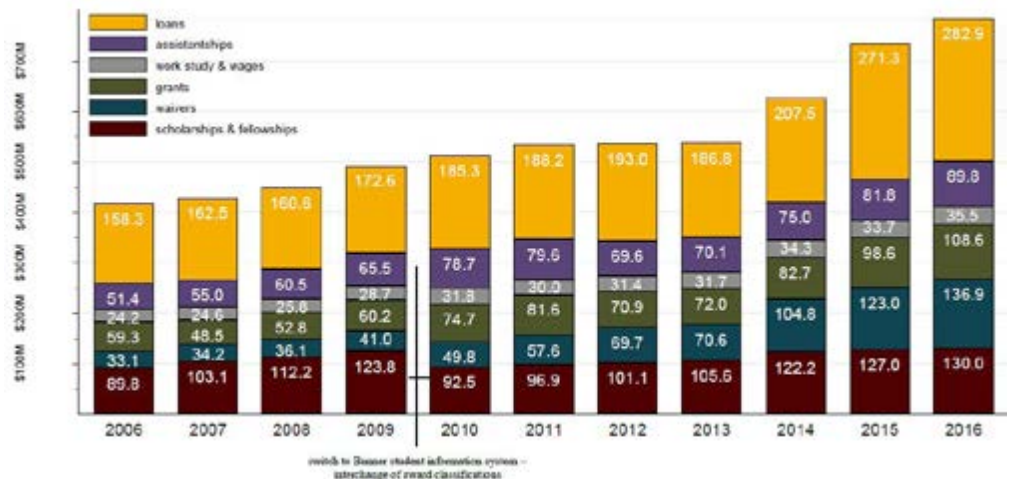
- \$783.7 million was awarded to all students through financial aid awards and student employment.
- 72% of all students received financial aid.
- 57% of all students received some form of gift aid (scholarship, fellowship, grant, or waiver).
- 25% of all students worked parttime on campus (work study, student wages, or assistantships).
- 33% of all students received a student loan.

Scholarships and Financial Aid also administers several large scholarship programs, assists with study abroad services, conducts money management seminars and workshops, and operates a full service Student Employment Office and Veteran Services Office.
