TOTAL GRANT DOLLARS AWARDED TO TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY¹ STUDENTS

- \$108.6 million was paid to all students through grants.
- 27% of all students received at least one type of grant.
- 21% of all undergraduates received a Federal Pell Grant
- The average grant package for all grant recipients was \$6,149

As one of the several forms of gift aid, grant monies do not need to be repaid. Grant awards are need-based and require the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). In the 2015-2016 academic year, 17,654 students received at least one type of grant, and receipt varied widely between undergraduate and graduate or professional level students.

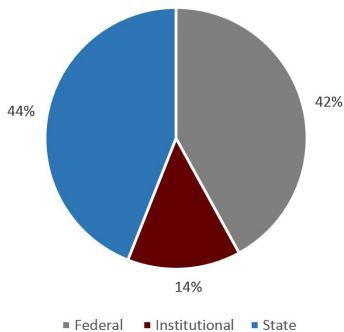

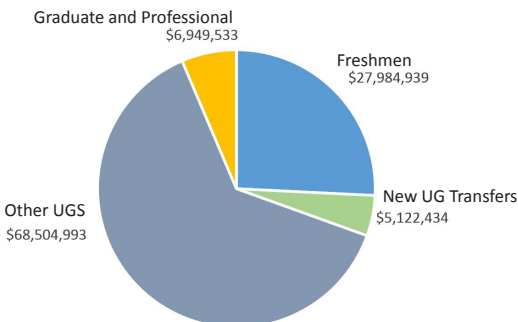
