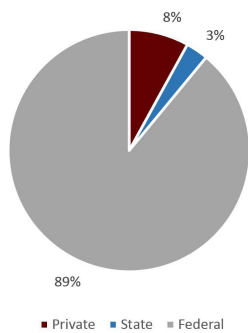
- \$282.9 million was paid to all students through loans.
- 33% of all students received at least one type of loan.
- The average loan package for all loan recipients was \$13,146.
- 9% of all loan recipients received a private loan.

Loans are a form of financial assistance that must be repaid, usually with interest. Most loans are funded by the state or federal government, and require completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and a Master Promissory Note. Loans can also be obtained from various banks and other private sources, which have their own terms and requirements. In the 2015-2016 award year, 21,522 students at Texas A&M had at least one type of loan in their financial aid package.

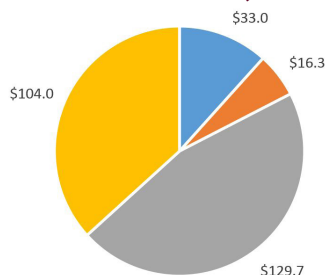
